Our multidisciplinary team includes a psychiatrist, psychotherapists, registered dietitians, registered nurses, and yoga-trained milieu therapists—all of whom support EDCMT's mission to light the way out of eating disorders, freeing patients to live wholeheartedly. We treat all genders, ages 12 and older, in support of our vision of creating a future where every patient can live out loud, having overcome their eating disorder through wide-open access to compassionate, expert patient care.

At EDCMT, knowing that treating patients with eating issues is complex, our clinicians are supported in ongoing learning opportunities to reinforce their existing competencies.
