Our multidisciplinary team includes a psychiatrist, psychotherapists, registered dietitians, registered nurses, and yoga-trained milieu therapists—all of whom support EDCMT's mission to light the way out of eating disorders, freeing patients to live wholeheartedly. We treat all genders, ages 12 and older, in support of our vision of creating a future where every patient can live out loud, having overcome their eating disorder through wide-open access to compassionate, expert patient care.

At EDCMT, knowing that treating patients with eating issues is complex, our clinicians are supported in ongoing learning opportunities to reinforce their existing competencies. We value clinicians with a growth mindset, who are excited to continuously hone their existing skills in working with patients across the spectrum of types and acuity of eating disorders, in support of our primary goal to empower each patient on a path to full recovery from both the mental and physical attributes of their eating disorder.

Position Summary:

EDCMT is seeking a compassionate and experienced **Lead Registered Dietitian** to guide our RD team and help drive excellence in nutrition programming. This leadership role acts as a vital link between the Nutrition Director and clinical staff, ensuring best practices, team development, and high-quality, patient-centered care across all levels of treatment (OP, IOP, PHP). The Lead RD also provides direct care through assessments, individual nutrition counseling, and supervised meal support.

Key Responsibilities:

- Serve as liaison between the Nutrition Director and RD team
- Lead onboarding, training, scheduling, and performance support for RDs
- Audit documentation and records to ensure clinical and licensing compliance
- Develop and refine individualized nutrition plans in collaboration with a multidisciplinary team
- Conduct assessments, individual sessions, and meal supervision for patients
- Coordinate nutrition-related programming and care with kitchen and lodging teams
- Participate in utilization reviews, case coordination, and treatment planning
