Our multidisciplinary team includes a psychiatrist, psychotherapists, registered dietitians, registered nurses, and yoga-trained milieu therapists—all of whom support EDCMT's mission to light the way out of eating disorders, freeing patients to live wholeheartedly. We treat all genders, ages 12 and older, in support of our vision of creating a future where every patient can live out loud, having overcome their eating disorder through wide-open access to compassionate, expert patient care.

At EDCMT, knowing that treating patients with eating issues is complex, our clinicians are supported in ongoing learning opportunities to reinforce their existing competencies. Position Summary:

The Lead Therapist at EDCMT plays a key leadership role, bridging the Clinical Director and Therapist Team. This position supports program excellence by guiding clinical staff, coordinating training, and ensuring compliance with best practices in eating disorder treatment. The Lead Therapist also provides direct care, including clinical assessments and psychotherapy, while fostering an inclusive, supportive team environment.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide clinical supervision to pre-licensed candidates and masters program interns
- Oversee onboarding, training, and ongoing clinical development of the therapist team
- Collaborate with leadership on program development
- Ensure documentation, assessments, and treatment plans meet standards and payer requirements
- Support insurance prior authorization reviews and level-of-care transitions
- Deliver individual, group, and family therapy across levels of care (OP, IOP, PHP)
- Maintain group curriculum, audit notes, support safety planning, and uphold QA processes

- Partner with University of Montana on outcomes data
- Participate in therapist hiring, staff support, and patient advocacy
